A Research

Research activities focused on exploring the techno-eco-social transformation of societies into a Global Sustainable Information Society. In particular, questions of an economy of the commons, degrowth, a critical theory of media, resilience and sustainability, sustainable cities, social self-organisation, and digital humanism were investigated.

In that context, among others, connections were established with Degrowth Vienna and Fridays for Future Vienna.

The pandemic impacted us such that we had to face cancelations of face-to-face events and we started switching over to online meetings and lectures. However, exchange of research or teaching personnel and postgraduate and PhD students – as foreseen by the agreement with Xi'an Jiaotong University in Xi'an, China – had to be postponed.

1 Projects

Preparation and execution of, or autonomous collaboration in, research projects by The Institute with or without funding:

- **Emergent Transformation**
Wolfgang Hofkirchner started a book project. The monograph will resume his book *Emergent Information* and devise a transdisciplinary theories framework for the third step in sociogenesis.
- **COVID-19 Epidemic Austria Simulation Model**
Peter Fleissner simulated the Austrian and the German part of the pandemic and proposed a European strategy for the starving out of the Sars-COV2 virus. He was among a committee of experts that recommended the German government to fix the number of 50 for incidences to enable politics to control the pandemic.
- **Information Ethics, Responsibility and Sustainability**
2020 was the first year of that project according to the contract between GSIS and the Faculty of Informatics and Statistics, Prague University of Economics and Business, 0013/VŠ/2020. Though personal meetings were limited, the following achievements have been made:
 - Tomáš Sigmund published a chapter in the book: Theoretical Information Studies, Information in the World which resulted from the cooperation between GSIS Vienna and Prague University of Economics and Business.
 - In September 2020, Tomáš Sigmund took part on the conference organized by the Institut für Design Science. He had a lecture on dialectics in nature which resulted from and harvested the discussions with GSIS members.
 - Also in September 2020, W. Hofkirchner was invited to the Senior Forum on The Philosophy of Information and the Development of Intelligent Society at Xi'an, China. His talk was about the ethical aspect of Artificial Intelligence: "Machines of loving grace" or "Tools for Conviviality"? A translation will be published in China besides an English version to be published in Germany.
 - In November 2020, W. Hofkirchner had an online lecture at the Leibniz Sozietät in Berlin on social systems which was influenced by our common development of system thinking.
 - In December 2020, W. Hofkirchner continued the discussion of discourse with a short research paper on the classification of disinformation with special focus on ethical implications.
 - A book on transhumanism (Transhumanism: The Proper Guide to a Posthuman Condition or a Dangerous Idea?) was published where Members of GSIS and Tomáš Sigmund have their chapters. The book editors were GSIS Members Hans-Jörg Kreowski and Wolfgang Hofkirchner.
 - Tomáš Sigmund prepared an article on ICT and metaphors which was earlier discussed and commented on by GSIS members.

- **Lernen lernen**

Sophie Huber-Lachner’s documentary “Lernen lernen” (“learn how to learn”) is still in production – Corona was slowing down the process and working closely with the protagonists was not possible. Hence, together with senior producer Markus Fischer (Fischerfilm) it was decided to resize the project to a TV documentary (45-60 minutes). Eight additional shooting days are planned.

- **glossaLAB**
 By the end of 2020, the project has reactivated its development plan, which was significantly slowed by several causes derived from the Covid-19 pandemic and related measures, which severely hit the countries involved. In particular, a new support was granted by Madrid Open University at the end of 2020 with the purpose of fulfilling project objectives and applying its development to educational contexts. At the moment, the development team has concluded several achievements:

 - (i) the conversion of the encyclopedic sources to markation language has been achieved,
 - (ii) the basic components of the platform are functional.

At the same time, other achievements are on the way:

 - (iii) the provision of new contents has been done continuously,
 - (iv) a trial platform for sustainable management of glossaLAB has been developed,
 - (v) the integration of a clarification activity in the context of several international congresses has been agreed,
 - (vi) the Spanish Association for General Systems (SESGE) is collaborating with glossaLAB in the recovery and conversion of encyclopedic contents in Spanish developed by Charles François.

- **Evolution of Information Processing Systems**
 Annette Grathoff presented *Überlegungen zum Speichern physikalischer Information in der Natur* at the annual Wittenberg meeting to which the *Institut für Design Science München* had invited.
 The proceedings of the IS4SI Summit Berkeley 2019 containing an article of her related to the project were published in 2020.

- **Historical materialism, critical media and communication theory**
 This book project of Sebastian Sevignani and Sevda Arslan had to be postponed due to overwork.

- **Edgar Morin: Das Leben des Lebens**
 The translation of Edgar Morin's second volume on Method, carried out by Rainer E. Zimmermann und Cecile Malaspina, was delayed. A new publisher was searched. In 2021 a public event is considered to show substantial progress.

- **Transhumanism**
 The book *Transhumanism: The proper guide to a posthuman condition or a dangerous idea?*, edited by Hans-Jörg Kreowski and W. Hofkirchner, was made available in the end of 2020 (imprint 2021). It was published in the Springer series *Cognitive Technologies*.

- **Systems Thinking Origins**
 Annette Grathoff, Robert K. Logan and W. Hofkirchner met personally at the IS4SI Summit 2019 in Berkeley. Hofkirchner's contribution to the project was published in the proceedings.
 Also, Hofkirchner's paper for *BioSystems (A paradigm shift for the Great Bifurcation)*, published in November 2020, is dealing with the issue.

In addition, several project proposals had been worked out and submitted for funding through intensive co-operation endeavours. One proposal was selected for a full proposal submission. The decision is expected in April 2021.

The General Meeting, held electronically 25-27 May 2020, confirmed Hofkirchner as **Director** und Allmer und Sevigani as **Co-Directors**.
