A Research

Research activities focus on exploring the techno-eco-social transformation of societies into a Global Sustainable Information Society. In particular, the concept of Edgar Morin's "Homeland Earth", the paradigm shift to a shared future for humanity, the meaning of life in the context of information processing systems, information ethics that is aware of the urgent need of achieving a quality leap to level up social evolution, the importance of educating global netizens, the assets of encyclopaedic knowledge, strengthening resilience in the pandemic, the shaping of technology for humane purposes, and critical theories that lay emphasis on the ineluctable function of commons are issues of investigation.

In that context, among others, connections were established with the Austrian Study Centre for Peace and Conflict Resolution.

The pandemic impacted us such that we had to face cancelations and postponing of face-to-face events. We compensated by enlarging online activities, recording talks and setting up an own video channel.

1 Projects

Preparation and execution of, or autonomous collaboration in, research projects by The Institute with or without funding (for details see our website <https://gsis.at/projects/>):

- **“Heimatland Erde”**

This project was our first project that was fully funded. In the framework of the “Homeland Earth” movement that was started by the *Austrian Study Centre for Peace and Conflict Resolution Schlaining* (ASPR) to propagate the idea of a unified mankind on our planet in the wake of French intellectual Edgar Morin, the idea came up to produce a documentary on that for pedagogical use. We formed a team with our film-maker Sophie Huber-Lachner whom we contracted to materialise the film, Werner Wintersteiner, an expert in peace pedagogy from the Alpen-Adria-Universität, as consultant, and Ursula Gamauf-Eberhardt from the ASPR that provided the financial support. The 20 minutes film was finalised in November. Due to the pandemic, the premiere was postponed to 2022.

- **Emergent Transformation**

The manuscript of the book project of Wolfgang Hofkirchner was submitted to the publisher in February 2022. The monograph resumes his book *Emergent Information* and rounds up the paradigm shift to a shared future for humanity with providing a transdisciplinary theories framework – the so-called Logic of the Third.

- **COVID-19 Epidemic Austria Simulation Model**

Peter Fleissner has still been simulating the Austrian pandemic.

- **Information Ethics, Responsibility and Sustainability**

2021 was the second year of that project according to the contract between GSIS and the *Faculty of Informatics and Statistics, Prague University of Economics and Business*, 0013/VŠ/2020. The situation was also affected by the coronavirus pandemic. Despite that, we worked and developed our cooperation:

- Tomáš Sigmund and Wolfgang Hofkirchner published in the field of Transhumanism and AI.
- Both institutions became members and supporters of the initiative Homeland Earth. An online talk on “Die Verknüpfung von Globaler Citizenship, Globalem Dialog und Globaler Governance“ was given at the ASPR Summer Academy.
- Both Sigmund and Hofkirchner were involved in organising a workshop at the *2021 Summit of the International Society for the Study of Information (IS4SI)*. A speech was given and the full paper prepared for publication in 2022.
- Both institutions were represented with presentations revolving around Discourse and Power organised in Wittenberg at the annual conference of the *Institute für Design Science, München*.
- Hofkirchner taught Bachelor online courses for students of Informatics at the *IMC University of Applied Sciences* in Krems, Austria, on the topic Reflections on Computer Science, Society and Ethics.
- Sigmund and Hofkirchner contributed to a festschrift for the German philosopher Rainer E. Zimmermann.

- **Lernen lernen**
After some break, Sophie Huber-Lachner's documentary "Lernen lernen" could, eventually, be finalised in February 2022. The title was changed to "Das Lernen (wieder) lernen".
- **SISI (Single Integrated Science of Information)**
This project was continued with further publications.
An invited speech of W. Hofkirchner at the ASPR Summer Academy devoted to Peace Policy in the Age of the Anthropocene demonstrated how imperatives for our time can be formulated by extending the scientific understanding of information to social information processes ("Die Verknüpfung von Globaler Citizenship, Globalem Dialog und Globaler Governance").
- **glossaLAB**
This project was supported by Ecuadorian institutions in the years 2019-2021. It faced financial problems. However, in 2021, it enjoyed grants in the educational context.
- **Evolution of Information Processing Systems**
Annette Grathoff published a paper "On the explicit function of life within a physical universe" in a special issue of philosophies on "The meaning of life in the universe", guest-edited by Rainer E. Zimmermann. Also, she presented her considerations on the topic at the annual Wittenberg meeting to which the *Institut für Design Science München* had invited.
- **Historical materialism, critical media and communication theory**
This book project of Sebastian Sevignani and Sevda Arslan is still postponed.
- **Edgar Morin: Das Leben des Lebens**
We have started negotiating with a new publisher of the German translation of Morin's second volume of "Method".
- **Transhumanism**
The book *Transhumanism: The proper guide to a posthuman condition or a dangerous idea?*, edited by Hans-Jörg Kreowski and W. Hofkirchner, was published with an imprint of 2021.
- **Systems Thinking Origins**
Contributions of W. Hofkirchner, i.e., lectures on "Die Verknüpfung von Globaler Citizenship, Globalem Dialog und Globaler Governance" (ASPR Summer Academy) and "The future of anthroposociogenesis: panhumanism, anthroporelational humanism and digital humanism" (5th ICPI) as well as his book project (Emergent Transformation) advanced the further elaboration of that project.

The full project proposal on transformative media submitted in January was not successful.
